



LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

SPRING 2022 - 134TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

1. Address the long-term solvency of the Unemployment Compensation Trust Fund. (sponsor needed)
2. Clarify and reinforce laws governing the ballot issue petition process.*
3. Improve Ohio's current D+ grade on the Council on State Taxation (COST) Property Tax Administration Scorecard. (HB 126)
4. Codify when work from home injuries are compensable. (HB 447)
5. Create a robust venture capital, private equity, capital formation environment. (sponsor needed)
6. Provide employers a tax credit to offset the cost of health insurance mandates. (HB 443)
7. Amend state wage and hour laws to clarify that de minimis amounts of time may be disregarded when calculating overtime pay. (SB 47)
8. Revise the Ohio EPA's definition and regulatory authority regarding ephemeral streams. (HB 175)
9. Pursue innovative ideas to grow Ohio's population and workforce.*

ACCOMPLISHED

- ✓ Reduce regulations on businesses that limit economic growth and increases compliance burdens. (SB 9) *Signed into law 3/10/2022*
- ✓ Provide incentives to businesses who offer work-based learning experiences for career-tech students. (SB 166) *Signed into law 12/22/21*
- ✓ Ensure that students will be equipped with an adequate level of financial literacy upon graduation. (SB 1) *Signed into law 10/28/21*
- ✓ Repealed sales tax on staffing services saving employers more than \$300 million over a two-year period. (HB 110) *Signed into law 6/30/21*
- ✓ Increased funding for TechCred from less than \$1 million to \$58 million. (HB 110) *Signed into law 6/30/21*
- ✓ Eliminated Ohio's unemployment loan saving employers more than \$600 million over a three-year period. (HB 168) *Signed into law 6/29/21*
