- Leads Impact Ohio Regional Events in their area engaging in partnership with their regional Chambers.
- Facilitates Ohio Chamber member meetings/tours in their area.
- Fosters relationships with local and regional chambers.
- Staffs Ohio Chamber CEO at meetings and events in region.
- Provides donor leads to fundraiser and SVP of Political Engagement.
- Provides membership leads to sales team.

- Provides support to CEO Forum pods in their region.
- Provides regional support to the Ohio Chamber Small Business Council encouraging those members to engage in advocacy efforts.
- Collaborates with other Ohio Chamber staff across the organization to ensure targeted and substantive delivery of membership services.
